
Who You Represent

It's May. May, that magical month of motorsport culminates this year with the running of the Monaco GP, the Indy 500 and the Charlotte 600 all on the same day. It is the ultimate smorgasbord of racing delight. All have their appeal. While I have raced at Charlotte and would love to experience Monaco (as if I could afford it) (I do have the poster!), Indy holds a special place in my heart.

My first visit to a race track was Indy for the 1965 Pole Day Time Trials. The enormity of the facility just overwhelms you. In fact, the Rose Bowl, Yankee Stadium, Churchill Downs, the Roman Coliseum and Vatican City all fit inside this hallowed oval. But beyond the 2.5 miles of the brickyard and the endless grandstands, it was finally seeing the stars of Indy and F1 at speed that grabbed me. Jimmy Clark, Jackie

Stewart, AJ Foyt, Parnelli Jones, and my heroes Dan Gurney and Rodger Ward flashed by at the speed of sound or at least in seemed like it. And the sound, the sound of the Offys, the Fords, and the Novis as they screamed down the 5/8 mile front straight into the tunnel of Turn 1 was a drug I have been hooked on ever since. Plus, I love the smell of methanol in the morning.

My memories of Indy actually go back to listening to the 500 on radio on Memorial Day 1962 in my back yard in Troy, Ohio. Rodger Ward won his second 500 and he was my guy. This year as I celebrated my 65 years on this earth my gift from my parents was a 1/18 scale model of the Ward's winning Offy Roadster. I love the flag type shield with the number 3 and the Leader Card 500 Roadster logo. Indy was one of the first places to have sponsors on the competitor's race wagons. Today in all pro racing the



drivers have obligations to represent those who make it possible for them to race and hopefully win.

When I was in London this spring and visiting the museum of the of my favorite Arsenal Football (Soccer) Club, a poster caught my eye. It featured the image of former Arsenal Star David Rocastle with his quote, "Remember who you are, what you are and who you represent." Good words for racers to live by. Great words for believers to live by.

2014 DRIVER'S CHAMPIONSHIP SERIES

ELIGIBLE DRIVERS

Any member of Neohio Region, SCCA who holds a Competition License or a Novice Permit is eligible. Drivers must be Neohio Members on the date of the event in which points are earned. In the event of Dual Membership, Neohio must be the region of record at the time the event is run before earned points are recognized.

ELIGIBLE EVENTS

National, Regional, and Novice Drivers must earn points in a Minimum of any four (4) SCCA National and or Regional races. Only the best six (6) finishes will be considered although drivers may enter as many as they desire and submit the results there of. No enduros, pro-races, or races for money will be counted. Only the longest scheduled race of the sanctioned event will be counted. Drivers must write the Region sanctioning the event, and the Day and Date the race was held on the result sheet. Runoffs or other Class Championship races will not be counted.

BONUS POINTS

Any Neohio Driver will be given ten bonus points for starting any Neohio event, with the exception of the driver school and enduro, for a maximum of 20 bonus points.

POINTS

Points are awarded for each event entered as provided in the "GCR", plus one point for each car BEAT finishing in class. The highest point total in each class from January 1, 2014 through October 31, 2014 will be considered in declaring winners of the series.

Ties in the final points totals shall be resolved on the basis of each driver's record of first place finishers: then if necessary, second place finishers: then if necessary, third place finishes etc., until all positions contributing to the point totals have been considered. In the event the preceding does not resolve the tie, the winner will be the competitor who raced against the largest number of starters for the races in his or her class. In cases where further tie-breaking is necessary, ties will be broken on the basis of which driver earned the total points first. First place trophies only will be awarded to the winner in each of SCCA classes. All Neohio licensed competition drivers are automatic entrants, so there is no need to register for the series. All that is necessary is that drivers report non-Neohio event points earned to the Pointskeeper. Copies of all OFFICIAL result sheets for your race must be included in reporting of points earned (except for Neohio events which will be automatically, recorded).

November 15, 2014.

Former SCCA Chief, Hall of Famer, John Bishop, Passes Away

TOPEKA, Kan. (June 9, 2014) –Former SCCA Executive Director and Hall of Fame inductee John Bishop died June 5 in San Rafael, California due to complications from a recent illness. He was 87.

Bishop is widely recognized as one of the most important names in American sports car racing, having served in multiple capacities with key sanctioning bodies that have shaped the sport. His leadership roles included a stint as the Executive Director of SCCA from 1962-1969, a dramatic period that saw fundamental changes in the operation of the Club.

Bishop is survived by his son Mitch, daughter-in-law Julia, four grandchildren, brother Peter Bishop and sister Ruth Rodger. His wife, Peggy, preceded him in death in August 2013, as did his sons Mark and Marshall.
