Call to Order: Meeting was called to order by Chairman Dave Lancaster at 7:03pm and guests introduced themselves.

Review of Minutes from the February 5, 2019 meeting were presented by Ray Glover for approval. A motion to accept the **Prior Minutes:** minutes as corrected was made by Bob MacDonald, seconded by Jason Pokines, and approved without objection.

Treasurer's The March Treasure's Report was previously emailed to the Board by Joe Blaha. A motion to approve the report

Report: as presented was made by Ray Glover, seconded by Bob Nick, and approved without objection.

Membership: In Tara's absence Jeff Blumenthal reported we have 483 members with 40 expiring.

Officer and Committee Reports

RE: Dave Lancaster noted that Neohio had a big presence at "Spring Training" and gave a recap.

Banquet: Duane Harrington distributed a Banquet Report. The Report showed a loss on the event of \$1,080.29 as the meals

were subsidized by the Region. Bob Nick had several suggestions for ways to attract additional attendees including: a raffle, Chinese auction, giveaways/door prizes (Mazza wines, books, etc.), speakers (Levy, Goodwin, Freddy Baker, Amy Ruman, Solo Champs, Road Racing Champs, Beasleys, Ann McHugh, etc.). Bob MacDonald suggested a survey

(Survey Monkey) "What would get you to the banquet?".

Rally: Dave Lancaster noted there are a few people interested in helping out with the Rally program and discussions are on-going.

Club Racing: Dave also noted there will not be an annual tech day this year and those needed needing an annual tech should schedule their own.

Street Jeff Blumenthal reported that he met with Bob MacDonald regarding the chairman transition. Additionally, it was noted that an April date would be difficult so they are looking at an early May date. Brenda Nick cautioned it might

be wise to avoid proms at the local schools.

Solo: Jason Pokines presented a proposed solo budget of \$800.00 for the 2019 season. A motion to approve an \$800.00

solo Budget for the 2019 season was made by Bob MacDonald seconded by Jeff Blumenthal and approved without objection. Jason also reported that he dropped the June solo that conflicted with the Time Trial, there will not be

any events at Lakeland this year, and trailer maintenance will be scheduled soon.

Rally Cross: Andrew Grannis was introduced as Neohio's inaugural Rally Cross Chair. He gave the following report:

He's met with the Detroit Region's Rally Cross team, rally cross is based on cumulative time of all your runs, course rental can be between \$500-1,200, entry fees are usually \$50-75, thirty second runs are a good target, and a good number of cars come on trailers. He is looking at several possible sites and would like to hold one event this year.

Old Business: Time Trial update by Bob MacDonald: the sanction request has been submitted and the date will be added to the

SCCA calendar. Mahoning Valley has asked to co-host the event, the percentage to be determined. The tentative schedule would have the morning being a "Track Sprint" format and the afternoon being "Time Attack" (similar to a club racing qualifying session). They are aiming for a 60 car breakeven point with a \$200± entry fee.

A motion to approve a 70% Neohio / 30% Mahoning Valley co-hosting arrangement was made by Ray Glover, seconded by Jason Pokines, and passed without objection.

New Business: Bob Nick made a motion to hold next year's banquet at the same place with the same deal as this year's (in Avon). Motion seconded by Maddie Oswalt and approved without objection.

Bob MacDonald moved to approve \$1,100.00 for the Treasurer to hire the same accountant as last year to file the Region's tax forms (1099). Motion seconded by Maddie Oswalt and approved without objection.

Duane Harrington requested a \$4,000.00 budget for the next banquet. Jason Pokines moved to approve a banquet budget of \$4,000.00, seconded by Michael Oswalt, and approved without objection.

Jason Pokines noted he needs \$16.00 to register our website domain name for the year. A motion to approve the \$16.00 was made by Bob MacDonald, seconded by Michael Oswalt, and approved without objection.

Adjournment: Motion to adjourn made by Jason Pokines, seconded by Maddie Oswalt, meeting adjourned at 8:43pm.

While the U.S. Air Force will be moving more planes there while Offutt AFB is dealing with the flood and its aftermath, the folks at LAP have been diligent to make sure that their presence will not disrupt the usage of the

site for any SCCA event planned, whether it be Nationals, Spring Nationals, or the Nebraska Region events.
