The Starting Line REport by Dave Lancaster

This month I have some sad news to report. On Christmas Eve 2021 we lost a true NEOHIO Region Champion, Bob Nick. Bob had been involved with the Club since 1986 and had participated as a competitor and volunteer in many ways. Most recently, he served as a member of the Board of Trustees for NEO-HIO Region and was a key member on our Timing and Scoring Team for both Club Racing and Time Trials. Bob was also very active during his membership time in our Road Rally Program both as a competitor and volunteer, competed in Club Racing, Solo, and the Longest Day of Nelson Ledges. He was one of those members that did it all for many years and kept our events running smoothly behind the curtain.

I got to know Bob when I joined the Board of Trustees for NEOHIO in 2016. Bob was already an existing Board of Trustee and with both of us having a Club Racing background we had many similar views. As I got more involved in the management of our Region, I learned what a true Champion of NEOHIO Bob was and his love for anything SCCA. Bob was always supportive of any Program that brought enjoyment to our members. His first love was returning to Nelson Ledges and in 2019 when we were able to host a Divisional Time Trial, Bob made sure NEOHIO was represented in the best light possible to our competitors and the new track management team. This was another quality that really impressed me with Bob, his concern for NEOHIO's image and our ability to put on a successful event were always on his mind. He may not have been the loudest member of our Trustee Team, but when he spoke, we all knew he was sincere and his purpose was not for self-glory, but for the good of the Region.

When it was time to go back racing, I witnessed his face light up when we got the green light. Away from his Trustee responsibilities, he and his wife Brenda handled the Timing and Scoring for both the Time Trials and Club Racing, and made that Specialty run smoothly for us on our return. Brenda is listed as our Specialty Chief, but they were clearly a team and we could not run these events without their leadership and involvement.

<u>Notes from the Director's Chair</u> <u>Area 4 Director Update for January, 2022</u>

December meetings actually started in November as I left the house on 11/30 to go to Kansas City, MO for the next Board of Directors (BoD) meeting which was held on 12/3, 12/4. As I have a cousin who lives 40 miles away in Lawrence, KS, I decided to go out a couple of days early to spend some time with her and her family. As usual, I used my electric car so I saved myself and the Club a lot of money by driving.

We welcomed a couple of new members to the BoD and said good bye to a couple more. We scheduled two more face to face meetings for 2022. One in July and another in December. The financials look very good. We reviewed all the programs (Club Racing, RallyCross, Solo, Road Rally, etc.). Some got an update from SCCA Enterprises, did some strategic planning as well as some governance training. Part of our July meeting will include some face to face governance training too. This was supposed to happen this time but Covid forced the training team to cancel their trip to KC. Pro Racing also updated us on the plan to move the program so its run by Parella Motorsports Holdings (PMH).

If you haven't already, please sign up for the <u>2022 SCCA National Convention</u>. Once again, Covid has forced us to meet remotely. It starts on 1/21 and lasts a week as it finishes on 1/28. There will be dozens of meetings and I'm sure there will be a great many that have application to what you want to get out of the Club.

In case you missed it last month, it bears repeating that our divisional Spring meeting will be on Saturday March 5^{th} with a casual gathering the night before. Details will be announced as they are finalized on the <u>GLDiv website</u>.

Last month I mentioned that there is a new path to getting your annual waiver. You can now get it through the Member Account Portal (MAP). Follow this <u>link</u> to get the instructions. There is also a story about the program <u>here</u>. I've done it and it takes only a couple of minutes. Be prepared to upload a headshot picture of yourself.

The various national schedules for 2022 are starting to coalesce and they can be found here: <u>Pro Solo/National Tour</u>, <u>Time Trials National Tour</u>, <u>Hoosier Super Tour</u>, <u>Enduro</u>.

Video Conference Meetings:

- Club Racing Board (CRB) (12/7): The post Runoffs onslaught now begins....everyone wants to see rules changes and they send them in by the scores. There were over 400 in the system this month. The results can be seen <u>here</u>.
- Electrified Vehicle Advisory Committee (EVAC) (12/8): Our discussions on rules sets, track relationships and safety continued. We hope to have a rules set posted soon.

BoD (12/16): We held a quick meeting to discuss some financial details. It was over in 30 minutes and I understood very little of the content (I'm a chemist, man!). Our CFO (Jeff Dahnert) does and that's

Dennis Freeman

Dennis Freeman began doing fire rescue at the Cleveland Grand Prix in 1992. He was already a firefighter when he started doing the race. He had been doing the 90 day program for fire rescue for years before doing SCCA/fire rescue when they merged them together. He started in the pits at Cleveland learning the ins and outs before moving on to trucks and in early 2000's being 2nd in command. He also trained Dave Browning when he came for the first time to Cleveland also showing Rich Nester the ropes at the Cleveland Grand Prix. Dennis joined SCCA full-time in 2005. He worked at Nelson Ledges Road Course taking over chief of fire rescue at the end of the race season in 2006. He built up one of the best safe-ty fire rescue teams. He received the Martin Tanner award which is presented to an SCCA worker who displays unusual courage while exposed to danger in 2010. (Denny would say it was the whole team that got the award.) He was Divisional Administrator for fire rescue for the Great Lakes Region until he passed away. In his time as chief he worked on safety days as well as a special training session with the local fire department to show what was done at race events. He worked with NEVDIV (MVR and Steel Cities) when he was asked if he would be the chief of rescue at their events. He worked two SCCA Runoffs in Topeka. He got several young people involved in SCCA, some who are still involved.

Dennis was on the board for NEOHIO as a trustee and worked the auto show for years. He worked Nelson Ledges Road Course, Pitt Race, Mid Ohio, Michigan, Indianapolis and Topeka.

<u>Pat Prill</u>

For about 30 years, Pat has provided constant and on-going support for NEOHIO filling in wherever she was needed and doing it enthusiastically. She has been a trustee on the NEOHIO board several times. In 1998, when she was Assistant RE, she stepped up to fill the role of Regional Executive when the previous RE died unexpectedly. Pat and her husband Paul, came up with the idea that NEOHIO should celebrate its 50th anniversary in 2002, and then they chaired the event. This was quite a celebration at the elegant Crawford Auto Museum. Pat chaired the Burke Lakefront Indy Grand Prix for NEO-HIO for ten years. She has chaired many races for NEOHIO and even now makes sure that all the race volunteers have refreshments. Pat has served as registrar for many NEOHIO races. In recent years, she has chaired NEOHIO 's annual awards event.

On the personal side, Pat is the matriarch of her racing family. She and Paul partnered in supporting racing, with Detroit Region when they lived there. Prior to moving to NE Ohio in 1983, Pat and Paul were members of Cincinnati Region for several years, where Paul was Regional Executive and Pat was race chair. She is a 49 year member of SCCA. Pat supported Paul's racing and now supports her son Eric's racing. Eric is SCCA's Vice President of Road Racing.

Mike Puskar

Mike has been an active, 40 year NEOHIO member in the road racing community from his own involvement as a driver in many Longest Day events to his current support with his company Carbotech Brakes.

Mike started racing in 1982. His club racing accomplishments include NEOHIO Regional Championship and Kryder Cup Champ SSA 1983, Central Division Championships SSB in 1987 & 1988, 4th place at the Runoffs in SSB in 1987. In Pro racing in 1987, he had two 2nd place finishes in the Playboy Escort Series. Mike was a driver, owner and manager in many Longest Day events from 1982 to 1991, winning his class 6 times.

He is extremely supportive just by his mere presence at many events across the country! Not to mention his sponsorship of NEOHIO events through the years.
