The Starting Line REport by Dave Lancaster

NEOHIO members if you haven't done so already, it's time to start your engines. May is here and our season has started with a Solo Event at Captains Club Parking Lot and a Track Night in America Event at Nelson Ledges Road Course. We still have three more events to get in this month including a Road Rally, a Solo Event, and a Time Trial at Nelson Ledges.

In addition to our own events, we have plenty of our members participating in many SCCA Events of all types outside our Region. NEOHIO Region was well represented at the PITT Race Super Tour with both Workers and Competitors. We also had a large turn-out at the Time Trial Nationals as well as a Solo National Tour this year.

As for Club Updates, there are two items that our members should know about. First is the postponement of the Longest Day of Nelson Ledges. This was a bit of a disappointment for potential participants and workers who looked forward to the return of this historical event. I have spoken to many endurance competitors that are very excited about this event, but felt they needed more time to prepare a car and team for the event. The NEOHIO Club Racing Team along with the management at Nelson Ledges agrees that this event will be more aligned with the current endurance racers if run under SCCA's new Endurance Program starting in 2022. The combination of both new car rules and more time to prepare should lead to a great event in 2022. The last factor that effected this year's event was the uncertainty due to Social Distancing and COVID we experienced in the off season.

NEOHIO Region has had some issues with finding a good location to host a Rally Cross event in 2021. We tried to work something out with Nelson Ledges, but the area will not be ready in 2021. Brian Ross then introduced Frank and I to the owner of the Southington Off Road Park who has two areas for us. This location already hosts motorsports events and is excited to work something out with us. Frank Colletti is working out the details and will soon have some news to share with us. I believe a late July date is being agreed upon. Anyone wanting to participate in Rally Cross events should contact Frank as he could use some help in planning and preparing for these events.

As always, I hope to see you all at an event this year. Remember to thank the volunteers who work hard to make these events happen.

Notes from the Director's Chair Area 4 Director Update for May, 2021

As we head into the competition season, I am reminded just how busy all of us are. Not just the competitors who have to get ready for the upcoming season but all the behind-the-scenes folks who make the races happen. They make the sausage, folks. They deserve a lot of kudos for all their hard work so the rest of us can play with our cars. No matter how you help "make the sausage", your efforts are not forgotten. The competitors, management of your division and regional officers salute your efforts on our behalf. And drivers, be sure to thank those folks in person and offer a generous donation to the Worker Appreciation Fund of the events you attend.

I had even more meetings this month for a couple of reasons. One, a new sub committee was formed under the Club Racing Board (CRB) called the Electric Vehicle Advisory Committee (EVAC) and we held our first meeting on 4/14. Details about this will be announced later. Two, an additional meeting was held by the CRB to focus on "strategic planning".

CRB on 4/6: This was a routine meeting and was finished in less than 90 minutes (a new record during my tenure). Nothing really exciting happened but we'll see how the driver corps accepts the results (which can be viewed here).

EVAC on 4/14: Again, details to be announced later.

CRB Strategic Planning on 4/22: Some long-term planning discussions were held. The Club Racing program is strong but the changing economy, Club demographics and other factors lend uncertainty for its future. The overarching theme of "how do we make the product better" was applied to a wide variety of topics. This will be an ongoing conversation so we're planning on meeting monthly to discuss these issues.

BoD on 4/26: I'll report on this meeting next month. RXB on 4/27: I'll report on this meeting next month.

My personal travels for race events started this month as I visited my brother in NC for a couple of days before heading to VIRginia International Raceway (VIR) for a Hoosier Super Tour (HST) event there. Due to COVID-19 restrictions, the race was considered a "private event" by the State of Virginia. This meant no spectators, no over crew and everyone had to be an SCCA member. They also limited the entries to 300 plus 'double dippers'. It was a very well-run event with nice weather (other than the Saturday night thunderstorms with a tornado watch in nearby counties).

I'll be off to Pittsburgh International Race Complex (PIRC) for another HST race on 4/30-5/2 and MidOhio for an OVR Major Club Race on 5/22, 5/23. OVR could always use more workers. Taping – write down car numbers as they pass Start/Finish.

Orbits Operator – uses a computer to make sure the cars register as they pass Start/Finish, and keeps track when things happen such as yellow flag, checkered flags, etc.

Orbits Results – publishes the provisional and final results of sessions, also hourly updates during the Longest Day.

Outpost – prints out and post results from sessions or hourly updates. For Time Trials, distributes rental transponders; also verifies return of said transponders.






