Bios of Neohio's Hall of Fame Nominees - 2018

Craig Chima

Craig Chima began his SCCA racing career in 1984. After karting and dirt bike racing as a youngster, he bought a 1600 Datsun Roaster from a friend and attended an SCCA driving school, during which he took 3 seconds off the previous owner's best time. After racing the car for two seasons in Regional races. he realized its limitations and decided to buy a well prepared National level H Production Sprite and raced it in his first Run-Offs in 1988 and 89. He then moved up to a 1275, F Production Midget and put it on the pole at the Run-Offs in 1993, 94, 95 and 96, winning his first Championship in 1994. Next came two seasons in Pro S2000 followed by the development of an Elva Courier which he put on the Run-Offs pole in 2002 and 2003, winning his second Championship in 2002. Craig's 7th Run-Off pole and his last SCCA race was in 2006 in an H Production Midget.

Craig's racing credentials alone would be enough to justify his induction, but he was also named SCCA's Mechanic of the Year in 1996, and has become a nationally recognized constructor and restorer of British race cars, concentrating on Lotus Sevens, Elans and Europas; as well as Midgets, Ginettas, and even a Mallock.

Debbie LaFond

Debbie LaFond is nominated to Neohio Region's Hall of Fame, 2018 based on the substantial contributions she has made to Neohio,herracingaccomplishments, and the assistance she has offered other drivers. Debbie has been very active in her 30 years as a Neohio member, serving as Regional Executive for four years, Assistant Regional Executive for eight years, Competition Board Chair for over 15 years, Board of Trustees for 10 years, Competition Clinic Committee for five years, and banquet awards chair for 20 vears. She also organized Tech & Driver Physicial Day for over 15 vears and was steward for the 24 Hours of Nelson Ledges and Regional at Nelson Ledges. She holds SCCA licenses as Steward. Tech, Registrar, and Flagging &Communications.

Debbie has been an accomplished driver starting in 1986, racing cars prepared by husband, Maurice. She qualified for the runoffs in 2007. She raced until 2014 in a Fiat 850 (HP), MG Midget (FP), Ford Fiesta (ITC) and Honda Civic (ITC, GT4, GT5, GTL, GP, & HP). Debbie won 12 NeOhio Championships, 6 Kryderracing Championships and 4 series 2nd place, 8 CenDiv Championship top 3, and 1 NeDiv Championship. She qualified for 3 Runoffs - in 2006 she finished 15th in GTL & in 2007 she finished 22nd in GTL.

Debbie and Maurice have mentored many drivers and have offered assistance both on & off the track to many more.

She is a great promoter and representative of NeOhio where ever she goes. Last but not least, she makes a damn good pie, which she shares with many at the track.

Gary Martz

Gary Martz is nominated to the Neohio Region Hall of Fame, 2018, based on his contributions to the region and the workers, his racing accomplishments, and his representation of the "racing spirit". He was an inspirational role model for our racing community.

In the 1970's, Gary became a regular fixture working Lake Erie Communications at Nelson Ledges and Mid-Ohio, volunteering many weekends.

Around 1990, Bob Roberts loaned Gary his RX7 for drivers school. Gary then built an Improved Touring RX 7. He moved up to EP and began a long string of Runoffs appearances. He did nearly all the mechanical work on his cars - his knowledge of what made them tick was profound. He was a great driver, but more than that he was always willing to lend a hand when another competitor needed help - often stretched out under someone else's car on Saturday evening of a race weekend. His help for other competitors included being with Sam Halkias when he took his national championship at Road America. A term that would describe Gary would be "sportsman". He was always willing to help a competitor however he could. He wanted to race his competition fairly on the track.

Gary was on the Neohio board and maintained the Neohio website, winning an award for the website from the national office. He worked as lead instructor at Driver's Schools.

Gary faced his is illness just as he faced his racing: with courage, dedication, and striving to be a better person. When Gary came in off the track he would immediately start to try to improve the performance or handling of his Mazda. When he was faced with the doctor telling him that he had one other option but the side effects would not be good and maybe he would not want to go through with the treatment, Gary told the doctor he knew what the outcome would be without the treatment but trying this treatment might improve his life or somebody else's. So they forged ahead. In the end, it did not help him but he was willing to try. That was Gary in a nutshell, always trying to do or be better.

Gary was a volunteer, racer, mentor, and friend to many. His loyalty to friends and respect to strangers alike was unmatched. Photos will be accepted with written submittals and separately. Photos need to include comments as to what they depict, when they were taken (if possible), and who took them.

ALL submittals will be credited to whoever made the submittal. I reserve the right to refuse any submittal. Anyone submitting a rejected submittal will be notified with the reason for the rejection so that they may revise their submittal. There will be no 'name withheld' submittals accepted without a very good reason.

After a small collection of submittals have been collected a website will be created and made available to anyone for viewing. The initial website may not include photos simply for the reason of getting the website up and running as soon as possible. It is my hope the website will encourage additional submittals.

At some point in time selected items may be combined into a book. I say selected items because I hope the scope of the website will be very big. For example, it would be great to have all of Ann McHugh's Longest Day letters included on the website, but only referenced in the book with a few excerpts. The same can be said for published articles which have appeared through the years.
