Remembering Chuck Dietrich

Charles H. Dietrich was a former Neohio member who passed away in July, 2013. He is remembered as a highly competitive racer who had the honor of holding SCCA Competition License #1. Since I didn't remember Chuck very well, I asked Dennis Sideri, FA driver to send me some more personal thoughts. Below are his memories.

Pat Prill, Trustee

I first met Chuck during my early days when I joined SCCA back in 1979 while hanging around with Paul and Kit Henry from Bellevue OH. Kit and Paul raced their Chevron FB cars in the F5000 Championship that I had the opportunity and pleasure to watch while at Nelson Ledges. Chuck had raced with their Father (Chuck Henry) back in the 1960's in a Elva or some other production based car.

When I first met Chuck (Charlie) he was racing his beautiful Yellow Lola FA car in the Mahoning National against some of the best FA drivers of its time: guys like Tommy Accult (not sure the spelling on that), Jim Truman, Dan Fowler, Patrick Garmen and a whole bunch of other guys I can't remember now but they were brilliant to watch and of course (to me)the King of FA, Mr. Dan Carmichael! Chuck and Dan were best buds off and on the track, and being a young (inexperienced) driver they both showed me respect and what true racing etiquette was on the race track. I still believe much of what I observed from their driving styles has helped me

Pete Sedlak called the meeting to order at 7:08 p.m. **MOTION** to accept the Minutes as corrected: *Roland Hahn/Jim Pracker – Approved.*

TREASURER'S REPORT:

- Thanks to Pete in helping get our membership monies back into our account.
- Should have accurate numbers next month for the race expenses as some invoices have not come in yet.
- MOTION to accept treasurer's report as presented. Roland Hahn/Duane Harrington Approved.

REPORTS & COMMITTEE REVIEWS:

COMPETITION COMMITTEE:

- The race came out a little better than budgeted. Really tried to keep expenses down. Next month will have the final expenses. We should keep consistent the outline for the Quad. Get our sanction early and get the word out there market it, post it, etc.
- Roland talked with many participants who shared they were happy with everything except for 1) move away from a holiday weekend and 2} for regional/national groups extend practice and keep race lengths the same. Getting workers was hard, but moving from holiday may help.
- Need collaborative effort to make a file of specialty positions and their duties so that new people coming in can gain an understanding, plus, if someone needs to fill in for someone, they have an idea what is required for that position.

MEMBERSHIP: Currently at 480 members. 10 new and 8 expired.

 It was noted that Bob had mentioned about stepping down next year and Jeff Blumenthal mentioned he would be interested in taking over/running for it if no one else was interested.

RALLY: No report.

- SOLO: First event went well. Had 59 entries of which 33 were non-members. Next event is August 11th. All are excited for it.
 - May want to think about possibility of adding "club classes" where we can get some cross pollination of local clubs involved and interested. Maybe even a go-kart class.

RALLYCROSS :

• All the rain has really not helped our location setup. May one do one event this year. Maybe more in the infield area. Discussions about rain and mud are a good thing for rallycross people, and should think about that aspect.

TIME TRIALS:

• No report.

OLD BUSINESS:

- STREET SURVIVAL SERIES: We could not secure a location. Bill Crowe is still working on it. Need to try to stress to potential sites that
 it is not a "driving school" but it is a "survival school". Pavement and a classroom area would be ideal, but even a trailer may work
 for the classroom. Insurance is covered through SCCA. Trying to plan on maybe in September or October, around the time school
 starts. Thinking that a Sunday would be better of two weekend days.
- HALL OF FAME: Committee met on Saturday at the National. Took a look to see what other regions are doing. Committee outlined
 rules for nomination, plan of future presentations and the need for a sponsor for the award(s). May only be one a year, more than
 one, or even none, based on what is submitted. Having another meeting to fine tune some things and will present in The Blower and
 online once feel all requirements are figured out.

NEW BUSINESS:

- Austin Healey club is having an event and Marie wondered if we would be there to represent? It will be put on webpage with general and contact information.
- Duane mentioned there was a problem with the website and some links. Especially the link from motorsportreg.com. Also that the calendar needs to be on front page of website so that people do not need to hunt it down. Make it there and visible on the front page. Pete will work on it and get links and calendar updated.
- Roland discussed a timing failure at the National. Our equipment is old and with new transponders and software, it cannot keep up
 with the loads and data anymore. Parts are not readily available anymore either. He talked about some general costs for upgrading
 the equipment. For the next meeting he will have cost for the decoder and new transponders for the board to review.
- Pete mentioned as he has a hard time hearing with all the discussions happening at once, he would like to step down as Board Chairman and have someone else run the meetings. He will remain as RE, but would like someone else to run the meetings.

even today with my driving and attitude with fellow competitors on and off the circuit.

Years later, Chuck had sold his LOLA and purchased a real race car (I told him that as a joke), a Martini FSV (Super Vee) which was previously raced in the Pro Robert Bosch Super Series by a very famous (later) French F1 Driver Didier Thyes. We always kidded him that he was going to be leaving us in SCCA and going across the pond to compete in F1 and be the next big super star. Chuck just smiled and would turn around and work on his car.

I think the best times and memories for me was with all the races he and I would compete with (while both racing FSV's) and both my all American Built FSV chassis by Jim Griffith from POLESTAR MOTORSPORTS against his French foreign car. Of course when you only see someone a few times a year it is hard to keep up with all the changes but we all age (expect him), looking back now but it was like he never aged to me. If anything, he seemed to go even faster (Dan sure did) and so it was like we were all still competing at the same level and with the same amount of intensity to win!

I remember the last event at Mid Ohio, we were sharing a garage together (like always) and he casually walked over and mentioned that this was his last race. At first I do not think it really registered with me (I think I was in the middle of fixing something on our car and trying to repair before the next Quail) but later he reconfirmed it was his last race. I honestly now cannot remember how we or he did that weekend only that I will never forget helping him load his car up on his little flat bed ramp and thinking to myself that this would probably be the last time I would have this opportunity to race with him again.

I was talking with Jane (Chucks wife) the other day and we were reminiscing on the old times and I had to ask her if she could clarify something for me that I had thought about for over 30 years. Sometimes when I was around both Chuck and Dan at the track I would hear Dan give Chuck a nickname "Wolfee" (Chuck and everyone always called Dan
