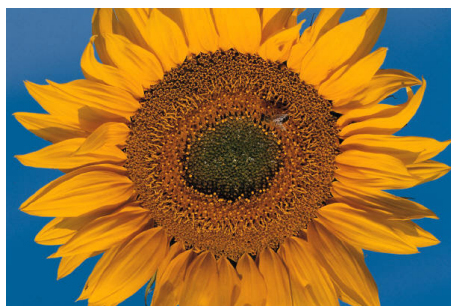

There are a few important things that I need to mention this month, so please read all the way to the end of the REport. I really hope that you read the complete report each month, but I know some don't complete it. These items are not in any order of importance since all are important.

The first item I have to mention is the passing of Denny Freeman. Denny was at Pitt-Race when he passed. He had taken on the position of head of emergency services at the race track. That may not be the exact title of the position, but that was his function. Denny was also the Divisional Administrator of Emergency Services for the Great Lakes Division. His involvement in Emergency Services goes back to the first IndyCar race at Burke Lakefront Airport. Later, Denny became a key person in the Nelson Ledges Safety Team and was instrumental in holding the group together during some extremely rocky seasons. He stuck with the team and was able to bring it to the top of the list in SCCA Emergency Services teams in the country. Denny Freeman was awarded the SCCA Tanner Award at the National Convention in recognition of the proficiency of the team in a particularly demanding rescue at Nelson Ledges. He accepted the award humbly and praised the NLRC Safety Team for their efforts. He then had a plaque specially made and mounted the Tanner Award on it

along with the names of every safety team member. There is much more that I can say about Denny Freeman because I considered him a special friend. In the past year the NLRC Safety Team has lost three very hard-working members, Jim Leagan, Ed Gaither and now Denny Freeman. Neohio Region has lost several several distinguished members also. It's been a tough year.

The next thing that has to be done is nomination of officers for the November election. Nominations will start at the September meeting. That meeting will be at The Captains Club in Eastlake on September 1. Offices that need to be filled are Assistant Regional Executive, Treasurer, Recording Secretary, Membership Secretary and three Trustee positions. If you have an interest in helping to run the region this is your chance. If you have questions about any of the positions please come to the meeting on September 1st at the Captains Club.
