SCCA has posted the 50th National Championship Runoffs schedule to the Runoffs home page at www. scca.com/runoffs.

The 2013 edition of the famed event will take place Sept. 16-22 at Road America, in Elkhart Lake, Wis. A special celebration will begin Thursday, Sept. 19 at 3 p.m., including a retrospective on the first 49 events, featuring some of the great names from the past, and a party that will be sure to go down in history as well.

The event will return to its tradition of three days of racing (Fri-Sun) to accommodate the celebration activities. The official week will begin with practice on Monday, Sept. 16, followed by three-straight days of qualifying, in which each class will make one appearance on track per day. The schedule is subject to revision for any reason up until Aug. 26, 2013



Ohio Winter Rally, **February 2, 2013**

Fifteen teams ran this year's Ohio Winter Rally on Saturday evening, February 2, 2013. The rally was the second round of the 2013 SCCA Great Lakes Division Rally Championship series. Returning Rallymaster Ken Swarm laid out a 115 mile course that led from Solon to Painesville via the Chagrin River valley, and returned via the Warner Hollow covered bridge, Mesopotamia and Middlefield. The rally finished at the Auburn Inn, a somewhat rustic tavern near LaDue Reservoir.

After a major January thaw, complete with warm rain early in the week leading up to the rally, there were worries that this might be another year of muddy roads. Luckily, a cold west wind brought some "lake effect" snow in the 2 days leading up to the rally. Road conditions were nearly perfect – fresh snow cover and little ice. Even though snow fell during the rally visibility was decent, and, unlike some years, there was no heavy drifting to contend with.

It was most heartening to see 7 Novice teams enter the rally. We sincerely hope to see these competitors return to contest future rallies.

It was also nice to have a large contingentofamateurradiooperators willing to spend their evening providing a communications net over a 3 county area (a tradition started by former Rallymaster Tom Kimball). Some of these "hams" doubled as control workers - an arrangement we intend to exploit more fully in the future.

U.S. Majors Tour - Where America's Best Amateurs Race

SCCA Announces 2013 U.S. Majors Tour Schedule At PRI

ORLANDO, Fla. (November 29, 2012) – Sports Car Club of America President/CEO Jeff Dahnert unveiled the U.S. Majors Tour schedule today at the Performance Racing Industry Show in Orlando, Fla. The highest level of amateur racing in the United States, the Majors schedule provides each Conference with a mix of tracks to form a geographic season-long championship.

"The U.S. Majors Tour schedule is one that many pro series would envy," said Dahnert. "Our drivers will compete at legendary and renowned circuits such as Sebring, Road Atlanta, VIR, Watkins Glen, Mid-Ohio, Road America, Circuit of the Americas and Portland International Raceway. Complimenting these venues are a host of Club Racing driver favorites to form four great Conference schedules.

All Majors Tour events on the schedule are doubleheaders, with the exception of the Chicago Region June Sprints, which will keep its traditional single race format.

Each Conference will crown a champion in all 28 Runoffs-eligible classes. Drivers will score their best finishes in two-thirds of a Conference's races. In the Eastern Conference, that means eight of the 12 available races; the Northern Conference will count seven of nine, and the Western Conference tallying six of eight races. The Mid-States conference would currently count seven of 10 races, but may see an additional race weekend added in the coming weeks.

The Gateway Motorsports Park event, August 3-4, will count in both the Northern and the Mid-States Conference.

As previously announced, points will count toward that Conference's championship, as well as to the SafeRacer National Series point championship and the traditional Divisional Championships.

Additionally, six premiere races will make up the BFGoodrich Tires Super Tour – Sebring International Raceway, Auto Club Speedway, Circuit of the Americas, VIRginia International Raceway, Mid-Ohio Sports Car Course and Watkins Glen International.
