The Starting Line Report by Bob MacDonald

Our season is in full swing! This weekend we are headed for another NEOHIO premiere event, **The Shortest Night of Nelson Ledges Team Enduro**. Endurance racing has a rich history in NEOHIO, as the original Longest Day of Nelson Ledges, which started in 1980, was the first race of its type. That 24 hour endurance race for production based automobiles became the prototype for the ESCORT series and many other similar events in the following years.

In the past 24 months, SCCA has expressed an interest in building a healthy new endurance racing model that gives our competitors a chance to once again work together in a team environment. Last May, NEOHIO put on the first SCCA Team Enduro and even though the turnout was small, the event was deemed a success. A lot was learned from that event, and the program has evolved a little. This weekend, we have the opportunity to show once again how important endurance racing is to the region.

With that said, we **need a whole lot of volunteers** to be successful. I'm pleased to see that as of this writing, we have 45 volunteers registered for the event on Motorsportsreg.com and a lot of them are competitors in other events who are supporting the region for this event. We would still be happy to have additional help in F&C, T&S, Emergency Services, Pit Lane, Start and Tech. It's also a great opportunity to see our events from a new perspective! Thanks to our title sponsor for this event, Tim Lally Chevrolet along with supporting sponsors Summit Racing, Hawk Performance Brakes and ECS Tuning.

Closely following this event, we have our **Mid-Summer Time Trials** July 8th and 9th at Nelson Ledges. This will be a great two-day event, but you can choose either single day or the full two-day experience. Saturday will be a full day of Track Sprints which I like to describe as a drag race with curves. Three different courses will be laid out on different sections of the track and each competitor will get multiple runs on each course. Your best time on each configuration will be scored. Sunday will be a full course Time Attack with each competitor getting a practice session and three sessions that will contribute to their score. Please come out and compete (First timers are welcome and will be mentored) or volunteer.

Call to Order: The Zoom meeting was called to order by R.E. Bob MacDonald at 7:32pm.

Review of Prior Minutes: Minutes from the April 4, 2023 Zoom meeting were emailed to the Board by Ray Glover for review prior to the meeting (note Tom Wieland, Matt Harbert, and John McFarland are still not receiving emails via the board's email list, Brandon Anderson to add them). A motion to accept the minutes as corrected was made by Kurt Stevens, seconded by Tom Wieland, and approved without objection.

Treasurer's Report: Joe Blaha emailed his May Treasurer's Report to the Board for review prior to the meeting. Joe noted it is consistent with last year's. He also noted the accountants have applied for a tax extension. A motion to approve the May Treasurer's Report was made by Matt Harbert, seconded by Kurt Stevens, and approved without objection.

Membership: Bill Snow reported the following:

There are currently 650 members. There were 31 new members in April. 18 memberships lapsed in April. Looking into MailChimp for our email marketing needs.

Notes from the Director's Chair Area 4 Director Update for May 2023

As I mentioned in last month's update, May was when I started to hit the road to go to divisional events. I went to two last month. A drivers school at Waterford Hills and a Major hosted by OVR at MidOhio. I have a couple more events scheduled in June.

So, here's what I did this past month.....

Video Conference Meetings:

Club Racing Board (CRB) (5/2): There was some discussion about the new BSpec revisions. We reviewed the GCR edits including a myriad of letters on GCR 1.2.3.D. We also chatted about potential alterations to the qualifying schedule for the Runoffs. A member had written the CRB (among others) about the use of leaded fuel in SCCA. While he made some valid points, we cannot eliminate leaded fuel from use in the SCCA. We will craft a reply to his letter soon. The results of all of the CRB rules changes can be seen here.

Electrified Vehicle Advisory Committee (EVAC) (5/10): A couple of members wrote letters to the CRB asking to allow Prototype Electric (PE) and Electric Touring (ET) to be included in the GCR. This is the next step in having EV classes in Club Racing. We discussed a myriad of topics (kill switches and whether to mandate them or not, how to handle hybrids, definition of an EV, etc.).

CRB (5/15): We met via Zoom call to discuss potential changes to the Runoffs qualifying format. In an effort to make the Runoffs more appealing, the CRB and national staff have been working on various potential revisions to the traditional schedule. We needed to meet to coordinate the town hall meeting that would be on 5/16.

EVAC (5/19): The EVAC had come up with some recommendations that would require input from Topeka about licensing, training, etc. We needed to chat with some folks there to make sure we were all on the same page.

Board of Directors (BoD) (5/22): The dust has settled on our external audit and financial parameters look pretty good. We also discussed several other topics (liaison reports, GCR revisions, etc.). The good news is that we did not have to set aside time for "members behaving badly".

GLDiv BoD (5/30): I met with the GLDiv BoD to discuss next year's divisional convention. As there is no national convention in 2024, we fully expect to have more support from the national office. We have a date (March 2nd) and are working on a location as Manchester University will be under construction next March. With no national convention to go to, regional leadership should be allocating funds for their members to go to our divisional convention. We will be content heavy so there will plenty to learn during the event.

SCCA Events:

Club Racing driver's school at Waterford Hills (4/28 - 4/30): Cold, windy and rainy.....weather conditions that would test the mettle of all involved. The good news is that rainy conditions mean that the students would pay more attention and it would dial down the "red mist" while on track.

OVR Major at MidOhio (5/12-5/14): I have always enjoyed going to MidOhio events. Whether it was as a worker, driver, media or as Director. This year was no exception as the weather cooperated which allowed good competition across the various run groups.

Please take a few minutes and make sure your contact information is accurate in the SCCA database. It's important to have the correct information there so the club knows how to contact you. Log in to your my.scca.com page and check.

As I mentioned previously, there is a new path to getting your annual waiver. You can now get it through the Member Account Portal (MAP). Follow this <u>link</u> to get the instructions. There is also a story about the program <u>here</u>. I've done it and it only takes a couple of minutes. Be prepared to upload a headshot picture of yourself.

Great Lakes Division Rally Championship Updates 2023 SCCA GLD Rally Championship Schedule:

The 2023 SCCA Great Lakes Division Rally Championship schedule remains a work in progress. The following dates are fairly certain:

Southern Ohio Forest Rally (SOFR), June 8-10, 2023:

For those who enjoy stage rallying (flat-out racing against the clock over closed forest roads), the **S**outhern **O**hio **F**orest **R**ally will take place June 8-10, 2023. The rally will start with a Thursday evening stage through Yoctangee Park in downtown Chillicothe. Friday and Saturday stages will run through Shawnee State Forest (near Portsmouth), and Zaleski State Forest (near McArthur). SOFR will be part of the American Rally Association (ARA) National Championship.

A "cast of thousands" of volunteers is needed to make this event a success. A variety of positions, both on stage and in the service areas, need to be staffed for the rally to run. Amateur radio operators and emergency medical personnel are in particular demand.
