Call to Order: The Zoom meeting was called to order by Assistant R.E. Brandon Anderson at 7:32pm.

Review of Prior Minutes: Minutes from the June 6, 2023 Zoom meeting were emailed to the Board by Ray Glover for review prior to the meeting. A motion to accept the minutes as corrected was made by Bill Crowe, seconded by Taylor Allen, and approved without objection.

Treasurer's Report: Joe Blaha emailed his July Treasurer's Report to the Board for review prior to the meeting. Joe noted a majority of the expenditures were for the Enduro and Solo. A motion to approve the July Treasurer's Report was made by Kurt Stevens, seconded by Brenda Nick, and approved without objection.

Membership: Bill Snow reported the following:

There are 649 members to date. There were 21 new members in June.

19 memberships lapsed in June. 29 memberships are set to lapse in July.

Road Racing: Debbie Lafond reported the following:

The sups. for the September race have been sent to Lauri Burkons for approval.

Entry fee is to be \$425 for two days. The race will count towards the 2024 Runoffs and Championships.

Enduro: Dave Lancaster reported the following:

The race went well, we learned a lot. 16 cars took the green flag. We lucked out with the fog.

Time Trial: Dave Lancaster reported the following:

The event was this past weekend. 50 Saturday entries.

At the last minute it was decided to use the track loops for Saturday's timing. It went well and there were lots of positive comments from the competitors. Possible Time Trial October 22, 2023?

Solo: Brandon Anderson reported the following:

The Saturday event last weekend with Leroy Engineering at Eastlake was sold out.

Sunday's Test & Tune was also sold out!

The Pro Solo at the IX Center is in two weeks. There were 200 entries in 43 minutes. July 21 will be set-up with racing on the 22nd and 23rd. This is a great opportunity to grow our Solo program.

Rally Cross: Brandon Anderson reported the following: Labor Day weekend event with the 944 Fest is still on.

Road Rally: Greg Lester reported the following:

An October 7, 2023 rally is in the works. Will try to work out the date conflict with Solo.

Old Business:

Bob MacDonald is reviewing the newest draft of the proposed Constitution.

New Business: Statement of Continuance fee has not been paid yet. Have until September. Bill Moore suggested that the Statutory Authority should be a Trustee. After additional discussion it was decided to table the designation of a Statutory Authority, but pay the fee now.

Duane Harrington noted he also receives the insurance mailings, maybe those should go to somebody else.

Brenda Nick would like to take My Laps timing system to the vintage race at Schenley Park July 22 & 23. A motion to allow Brenda to take the My Laps timing system to the vintage race was made by Bill Crowe, seconded by Kurt Stevens, and approved without objection.

Brandon Anderson is requesting a Pro Solo budget of \$9,500 with an expected \$1,000 loss. The budget is comprised of approximately \$1,000 miscellaneous supplies, \$2,500 social at Boss Pro-Karting, and \$6,000 of expenses that get reimbursed from National. A motion was made by Bill Crowe to budget up to \$10,000 for the Pro Solo, seconded by Taylor Allen, and approved without objection.

Adjournment: Motion to adjourn made by Bill Crowe, seconded by Ray Glover, meeting adjourned at 9:09pm.

Next meeting will be August 1, 2023 via Zoom.

Notes from the Director's Chair Area 4 Director Update for August 2023

July was a bit of a slower month for me. It'll pick up in August as I have three consecutive weekends that will have me on the road. First are the face to face meetings with the CRB and BoD in Kansas City (8/1-8/6). The following weekend, I'll be at the CAM Solo event in Indiana (8/11, 8/12) as well as a Club race at Mid Ohio (8/13). That will be followed by flagging a Club Race at Grattan (8/18-8/20). Whew...no rest for the wicked, right?

All that said, my hip is scheduled to be replaced on 10/5. I'm not sure which, if any, of the championships I will attend....or be allowed to attend. I'll keep everyone updated.

So, here's what I did this past month.....

Video Conference Meetings:

Club Racing Board (CRB) (7/5): The CRB discussed a variety of topics as they prepare for their face to face meeting in Kansas City in August (8/3, 8/4). They reviewed the letters that came through the portal, discussed responding to a member about leaded fuel and worked on an F&C update about licensing. There was also a presentation by Eric Prill about an in-car flagging system called Flagtronics. With corner worker staffing declining, the Club needs to work on other methods to maintain control of the field on track. The results of all of the CRB rules changes can be seen here.

Electrified Vehicle Advisory Committee (EVAC) (7/12): With last month's meeting cancelled and some question about the role EVAC has in the Club, we held a meeting with updates about our own action items (SCREV updates, training, decals, etc.).

EVAC (7/18): The Solo Events Board (SEB) had come up with some questions about the SCREV and Solo. As a result, a small group of us walked through those questions with Nick Dunlap. He would report back to the SEB and get them prepared for the face to face BoD meeting in Kansas City in August.

Board of Directors (BoD) (7/24): As we are having a face to face meeting in August (8/4, 8/5) we decided to cancel this meeting.
