## The Starting Line

It's September, we're heading into the final lap of the 2023 competition season and there's still a lot of opportunities for #funwithcars ahead. For openers, and to learn more about any of our programs, come join us at the Hoppin' Frog Brewery at 1680 Waterloo Rd. in Akron at 6:30 PM for our September (27<sup>th</sup>) **Social Event**. This is a pay as you go event.

On October 7<sup>th</sup>, we will be putting on the **Johnny Appleseed Road Rally.** This is an event with a long history here in NEOHIO. It's a straightforward TSD Rally that will cover approximately 165 miles through the rolling hills of Tuscarawas and surrounding counties. There are already entries from across the Northeast United States and it promises to be a good event. The event counts toward both the Great Lakes Division Rally Championship and the SCCA National Touring Rally Championship. However, don't be intimidated if you have never run a rally before. Our Rally leadership team will happily help you learn the ropes and they have built in some fail safes to help new teams avoid getting too far off course. Come and enjoy a beautiful, albeit spirited drive through the country. Registration is open on MSR or can be found through the NEOHIO website.

On that same date, we are hosting **Autocross Points Event 6** at the IX Center. This Solo series has been well attended all summer and I can say from personal experience that the IX Center is a great venue for these events. Registration should be open soon.

On October 21<sup>st</sup>, we will be wrapping up the Time Trials season with a one-day **Time Attack** event at Nelson Ledges Road Course. There will be run groups for Novice, Intermediate and Advanced drivers. If you have never tried Time Trials before, this is a perfect opportunity to check out this form of competition. Novice classes and coaching will be included. Registration for competitors and volunteers is now open on Motorsports Reg (MSR).

To finish out October, NEOHIO is once again partnering with Mahoning Valley Region to present the **Halloween Divisional Road Race** weekend at Nelson Ledges. This year's event will once again include a 90-minute Enduro (Club Race Experience or CRE) event on Saturday afternoon. On Sunday, instead of running a Track Event, we have extended the feature race sessions to provide maximum track time before we all go into winter hibernation. Registration for competitors and volunteers should be open soon (maybe even before you get this newsletter).

Call to Order: The Zoom meeting was called to order by R.E. Bob MacDonald at 7:33pm.

**Review of Prior Minutes:** Minutes from the July 11, 2023 Zoom meeting were emailed to the Board by Ray Glover for review prior to the meeting. A motion to accept the minutes as corrected was made by Bill Crowe, seconded by Tom Wieland, and approved without objection.

**Enduro:** Dave Lancaster reported the following:

There were over 30 responses to the survey with only one negative. 87% positive.

**Time Trial:** Dave Lancaster reported the following:

Solo: Bob MacDonald reported the following from Brandon's text to him:

The Pro Solo went spectacularly, including the welcome party at Boss Pro-Karting. Thanks to Boss Pro-Karting for the facility and Hoppin' Frog for helping provide the beer. We had lots of help from lots of people across the Neohio membership – thank you – it would not have been a success without you. You are all superstars. The national office would like to have more events with us, whether another pro solo or a tour of that. This is very exciting news. There was a lot of positive feedback on the event. There were approximately 189 competitors and 22 volunteers, 16 of whom were from Neohio. National also noted this was the fastest that a national autocross has been organized.

Out next event is August 18 at the IX Center. Trying to get the west lot (the same one used for the pro solo).

# Notes from the Director's Chair Area 4 Director Update for September 2023

August was pretty hectic. First are the face to face meetings with the CRB and BoD in Kansas City (8/1-8/6). The following weekend, I'll was at the CAM Solo event in Indiana (8/11, 8/12) as well as a Club Racing event at MidOhio (8/13). That was followed by flagging a Club Race at Grattan (8/19, 8/20). September doesn't slow down as I'll be at the Solo Nationals (9/3-9/9) and the Runoffs (9/23-10/2).

As an aside, I bought a new EV on 7/31 and as of this writing she has 4,515 miles. Trips to KC, Grissom/MidOhio, Grattan and the Halkias memorial service all added up to a lot of cockpit time these past few weeks. With Championship season upon us, there will be many more in the next month before my hip replacement surgery on 10/5. With all of that on my plate next month, I may not have time to craft an October update for you. But I'll be sitting around a lot after my surgery so count on one in November.

So, here's what I did this past month.....

### Video Conference Meetings:

- Club Racing Board (CRB) (8/1): As I was driving to Kansas City for the CRB and BoD meetings, I was not able to sit in on this meeting. The results of all of the CRB rules changes can be seen here.
- Electrified Vehicle Advisory Committee (EVAC) (8/9): With a bit of a hiatus due to the BoD meeting, we reviewed our action items and plotted a course for moving forward during championship season.
- Board of Directors (BoD) (8/22): The BoD got an update from Heyward Wagner on the incident at the Hillclimb event that had a fatality.
- BoD (8/28): We had a short agenda as championship season is coming up and all programs are preparing for that. Our financials look fine. We are behind the curve a bit as YTD entries and sanction fees are down due to poor weather in the early part of the year.

#### SCCA Events:

- CRB meeting (8/3): We discussed some of the long term, strategic topics that were brought up back at the spring face to face meeting. How would the Runoffs change in the next few years? What classes would be involved? How would the Club Racing program differ from its current incarnation? We also chatted about more immediate issues like "halos" on formula cars, the SMX class, in car flagging systems, etc.
- BoD meeting (8/4, 8/5): The BoD meeting would last two days so we could cover the usual oversight items (financials, program status, Enterprises, etc.) but also work on our own governance (bylaws, term limits, etc.). It was an effective series of meetings, and we continue to lay the groundwork for future success. We have a very good set of Directors all working for the greater good of the Club.
- CAM Challenge @ Grissom AFB (8/12): Raliegh Boreen has invited me to CAM events for quite a while, but something was always in the way. This year I made it a priority to make sure that I attended one of these events.

While I've been to plenty of Solos and even participated in quite a few, I was not prepared for this event. Yes, I'd seen the CAM classes run at the Solo Nats last year but I didn't get a chance to talk to the drivers too much. This was different. I walked amongst the grid and was able to chat with several of the drivers. And what a wide variety of drivers it was! There were many unique stories that led them to CAM. This set of classes has developed its own culture and there is a tight knit group of members participating. That spells success in the SCCA.

The on track action was neat too. The course was long and the competition was fierce. I was told by Velma Boreen that I would be passenger on one of her runs. What a blast! That gal knows what she's doing behind the wheel. Then the rains came. I was lucky enough to not get soaked. It was interesting watching the big cars dash through the puddles.

OVR Double Regional at Mid Ohio (8/13): After the Solo I drove over to Ohio, stayed the night and went to the Mid Ohio course for day two of a double regional held there by OVR. The car count was a bit depressed due to the fact that there was a race there two weeks earlier hosted by Cincy Region. The main reason I was there was to cheer on the HProd folks who were gathered en masse for the H Production Invitational. As this was my class back in the day, it was nice to see all the usual faces and cars as well as some new ones. Even my old steed was there piloted by a buddy of mine who bought her from me. Chris Schaafsma (defending HP Champion) ran away with the race but there were battles all through the field. It was quite a site to see 30 HP cars on track at once.

Sam Halkias Memorial Service: I want to take a minute to write about the loss of a colleague to this Club. Sam Halkias was a long-time friend who was very supportive of me (and MANY others) when I was just starting out. He was always there with advice, tools and parts (we ran similar old British sports cars). He paid it forward for guys like me and made it easier for the next generation to get into the Club Racing game.

He was the EP Champion in 2009 and I will NEVER forget that race. In a driving rainstorm, he piloted his TR6 to victory at Road America. Several of us watched from T3. We hustled up to the winners circle and I had the pleasure of being the first to shake his hand when he climbed out of his car. He was so happy. All the years of work and preparation had paid off in a title. Someone handed him a phone and he called his wife. He voiced cracked as he told her the good news. As he was a solitary guy at the track (no crew, no family), I had never met her until the service last Friday (8/25). It was heartening to see all the SCCA members who attended the service.

I thought it so apropos that he was buried in his drivers suit with a checkered flag. He will be missed.

## **Rally Update**

Johnny Appleseed Rally, Saturday, October 7, 2023:

Neohio will host the Johnny Appleseed rally on Saturday, October 7, 2023. The Johnny Appleseed name is a legacy from a National rally that traces its roots to the 1950's.

Competitors can expect an absolutely straightforward Time-Speed-Distance (TSD) rally, with the emphasis on precise timing at well placed controls. Columnar "tulip" style route instructions (similar to those used in stage rallies) will be used. In an attempt to help those with limited prior timekeeping experience, parenthetical perfect cumulative leg times will be provided in each instruction containing a speed change.

Starting in North Canton, the route will wind through the hills of Ohio's Tuscarawas, Harrison and surrounding counties (Muskingum Watershed Conservancy District).

#### SCCA Great Lakes Division (GLD) Rally Championship News:

#### Press On Regardless (POR) Rally

Neohio was well represented at Detroit Region's grueling Press On Regardless (POR) rally September 8th and 9th. This year's POR consisted of two very brisk rallies totaling approximately 450 miles of (mostly unpaved) forest roads in the far northern portion of Michigan's Lower Peninsula.

Neohio members Ron Johnstonbaugh and Ron Moran placed first overall in the Friday rally, bettering the New England team of L. Pictured below is a photo taken at the race showing the "Lunch Ladies" team she would put together for the Nelson Ledges events.


