October is a very busy month here in NEOHIO Region. There are still a couple more opportunities to get out and have #funwithcars before closing out the 2023 season.

On October 21<sup>st</sup>, we will be wrapping up the Time Trials season with a one-day **Time Attack** event at Nelson Ledges Road Course. There will be run groups for Novice, Intermediate and Advanced drivers. If you have never tried Time Trials before, this is a perfect opportunity to check out this form of competition. Novice classes and coaching will be included. Registration for competitors and volunteers is now open on Motorsports Reg (MSR).

On that same date, we are hosting **Autocross Points Event #6** at the IX Center. This event was originally scheduled for October 7<sup>th</sup>, but the decision was made to postpone based on the weather that weekend. This is your last chance to accumulate points toward the NEOHIO Solo championship in each class. Registration is open now on MSR.

To finish out October, NEOHIO is once again partnering with Mahoning Valley Region to present the **Halloween Divisional Road Race** weekend at Nelson Ledges. This year's event will once again include a 90-minute Enduro (Club Race Experience or CRE) event on Saturday afternoon. On Sunday, instead of running a Track Event, we have extended the feature race sessions to provide maximum track time before we all go into winter hibernation. Registration for competitors and volunteers is now open. Please come and join us for this last hurrah of the regular road racing season.

Looking back for a moment, On October 7<sup>th</sup> we hosted the **Johnny Appleseed Road Rally.** Thanks to Greg Lester (Rally Program Chair) and Ron Johnstonbaugh (Event Chair) for putting on a wonderful event. # **Trustee Meeting Minutes September 5, 2023**

**Call to Order:** The Zoom meeting was called to order by R.E. Bob MacDonald at 7:32pm.

**Review of Prior Minutes:** Minutes from the August 1, 2023 Zoom meeting were emailed to the Board by Ray Glover for review prior to the meeting. A motion to accept the minutes as corrected was made by Kurt Stevens, seconded by Tom Wieland, and approved without objection.

**Treasurer's Report:** Joe Blaha emailed his September Treasurer's Report to the Board for review prior to the meeting. Joe noted the month is down approximately \$4,000 over last month, but approximately \$4,000 over the same time last year. He added that the region will get reimbursed for the Pro Solo expenses. A motion to approve the August Treasurer's Report was made by Brenda Nick, seconded by john McFarland, and approved without objection.

**Membership:** Bill Snow reported the following:

There were 13 new members in August, 11 memberships lapsed in August. We currently have 674 members per national.

Bill has forwarded the new member list to the Board so they can reach out to those in their area or with similar interests.

#### **Officer and Committee Reports:**

**Regional Executive Report:** Bob MacDonald reported the following:

There were two good events since our last meeting – an autocross and a rally cross.

Dorothy Harrington brought to Bob's attention that John Hinkle is having some serious health issues and suggested a donation jar at the Pat Prill Memorial Race registration table. Bill Moore made a motion to allow a donation jar for John at the race, seconded by Kurt Stevens, and approved without objection.

Next year's calendar of events needs to be better coordinated amongst our own events to prevent conflicts.

The Communication Committee has not resumed meeting yet.

Keep thinking about the upcoming elections and awards. Keep supporting our sponsors.

**Road Racing:** Dave Lancaster reported the following:

The Pat Prill Memorial Race is September 16 and 17. We are short on F&C workers. Carbotech has sponsored the food for the Saturday evening dinner. Lyn Roberts needs an estimate of the number of attendees so she can order the food. Dave suggested approximately 200 should be a good number. Dave noted the entry fee for the race was approved by the Board to be \$425, but it was listed on MSR as \$395. It was decided to allow those who already registered to keep the lower fee but to put the correct fee for all new registrants.

Bill Crowe will be the Flag Chief for the Halloween Race in October.

#### Video Conference Meetings:

Electrified Vehicle Advisory Committee (EVAC) (9/13): With the President's update later that evening, we had a shortened EVAC meeting. We covered previous action items. We discussed roll cage requirements for heavier competition vehicles.

Board of Directors (BoD) (9/25): With the Runoffs in progress, meeting cancelled.

#### **SCCA Events:**

SCCA Solo Nationals (9/3-9/9): This was my second trip this the Solo Nationals. After having such a great time last year, I just HAD to come to the 50<sup>th</sup> edition of the event this year. With over 1300 entrants, it was sure to be a special time for everyone involved.

I arrived on site Monday afternoon and got set up. Even though I had attended last year, this would still be a learning experience for me. I knew there were classes that I had to view and an agenda of folks I wanted to talk with during the week.

On Tuesday night, there was a dinner and museum trip scheduled. I'd never been to the <u>Museum of American Speed</u> but it is a fantastic place to visit. They have a HUGE section of cars and memorabilia there. I strongly suggest you visit the place next time you're in Lincoln. You will not be disappointed. Wednesday, I was included in a meeting with the museum management to discuss cooperation on an SCCA display. We have entered a long term agreement with the museum and I look forward to a variety of SCCA cars being displayed.

As it is impossible to say "no" to Raleigh Boreen, I was talked into handing out trophies on Friday. How cool was this? I got to meet dozens of participants and give them hardware to honor their efforts.

As I mentioned previously, there is a new path to getting your annual waiver. You can now get it through the Member Account Portal (MAP). Follow this <u>link</u> to get the instructions. There is also a story about the program <u>here</u>. I've done it and it only takes a couple of minutes. Be prepared to upload a headshot picture of yourself.
