2024 Neohio Hall of Fame Induction

To honor those who contributed to the region through their volunteer work or who brought honor to the region for their accomplishments

Neohio Region would like to thank the Hall of Fame Committee for their time, effort and selection process. Sherrie Weitzenhof, Chair, Jeff Blumenthal, Dorothy Harrington, Brenda Nick and Bob Roberts.

Dorothy Harrington

We are inducting Dorothy Harrington into the Neohio Hall of Fame because for about 45 years, she has provided constant support for Neohio Region and SCCA. Dorothy joined the region in 1979 and became registrar in 1980. While chief registrar for Neohio, she has also served as registrar at events organized by other regions, holding a national license from 1982 - present. She was Divisional Administrator for Registration for CenDiv and Great Lakes Division for 20 years. Dorothy served as registrar for the Runoffs from 1994 – 2003 and 2011. She was SCCA worker of the year in 1990 and 1997. She has also been registrar for Pro events, including Trans Am, S2000, Formula Atlantic, World Challenge and Can Am.

Dorothy has supported Neohio Region in many other ways. She served on the Neohio board from about 1998 – 2001. She supported the organization of various Neohio activies, such as the 50th anniversary celebration and Competition Clinics. She started the Neohio Hall of Fame in 2013, serving as chair of the committee for many years; and still serves on the committee. She was the Neohio Pointskeeper for 35 years and was on the Competition Board for 25 years.

On the personal side, Dorothy supported the racing careers of her husband, Duane, as well as son Don.

William Scott Stewart (Bill)

Bill has been selected for the Neohio Hall of Fame because he has contributed so much to Neohio and SCCA for decades.

He grew up interested in cars, influenced by his father who worked for Volkswagen of America, and started attending sports car races while in college. After returning to Erie PA in the late 70's he autocrossed with Misery Bay Region and occasionally with WNY, NEOSCC (an Ashtabula/Lake County car club) and Neohio. In 1980, Bill became an SCCA member and volunteered as a Pit Marshal at Nelson. He was accepted as a Pit Marshal at the Detroit F1 Grand Prix in 1983, and he continued until the last F1 Detroit race in 1988. He also worked F1 at Indy and COTA. Over the years, Bill has worked for Trans-AM and World Challenge from Mosport, to Sebring, and to Sears Point. He also worked pit and grid at Formula-E races in Brooklyn. Bill did pits at Nelson, Mid-Ohio, the Glen, and Mosport and even the Niagara Falls Trans-AM Grand Prix in 1988. Since his 1996 retirement, he has worked over 20 Runoffs, becoming SCCA Pit Marshal of the Year in 2004, and Chief Pit Marshal at the Mid-Ohio, Indy, and VIR Runoffs. He was Misery Bay's RE for 1998 & 1999, while the region earned SCCA's Small Region of the Year in 1999, and has been their RE the last 2 years. In the Northeast Division, Bill was the DA for Pit and Grid for 6 years and has been a Member at Large on their Board of Directors for the last 5 years.

While Bill had worked most of Neohio's races and ran the occasional Neohio Solo or Road Rally, he became more involved when he first worked pits at the Cleveland Grand Prix and then became a Neohio member and Chief Pit Marshal there from 2005 to 2007. Over the years, Bill has worked with Greg Lester with numerous road rallies. He also has helped Neohio with their Teen Street Survival Schools and most recently, Time Trials. Neohio awarded Bill the 2014 Elden "Dutch" Moore Award, and the 2020 Reed Andrews Friendship Award.

In addition to SCCA, Bill started attending Corvette Cleveland Time Trials and Porsche Club Schools at Nelson Ledges in the 1980's. He became an instructor in 1987 and has driven tracks from Daytona and Mosport to Laguna Seca, and even Spa and Nürburgring. Bill also belongs to the Audi, BMW, and Porsche clubs.

The last 5 years, he has helped run Nelson's "Wonderful Wednesdays" track days and SCCA's Track Night in America at Nelson and Pitt Race.

Bill has worked and driven 17 race tracks throughout the US; driven but not worked 7 tracks; worked but not driven 8 tracks; and visited 8 other tracks throughout the world. This year he helped put out a substantial fire at the Runoffs and then had to miss the last day with COVID.
