Notes from the Director's Chair  
Area 4 Director Update for November



With “Championship Season” over for the year in SCCA, it’s time to start preparing for next year’s events. For those of you who don’t know what goes on behind the scenes, I encourage you to reach out to your region and get more involved. Understanding how the club works is essential for everyone to get the most out of it.

So, here’s what I did since my last report.....

Video Conference Meetings:

Club Racing Board (CRB) (9/3): Class consolidations and Hoosier Super Tour (HST) run groupings were discussed extensively. There had been a lot of blow back to the plans and some adjustments were made. As most of this group would be attending the Runoffs, there was some discussion about having common talking points to make sure we were all speaking with one voice. The results of all of the CRB rules changes can be seen [here](#).

Electrified Vehicle Advisory Committee (EVAC) (9/11): After getting feedback from the Touring Advisory Committee (TAC), we collated and polished the data for spec lines in Electric Touring. A group of us worked on getting an article ready for the website.

Board of Directors (BoD) (9/23): Our financials continue to be very favorable. We are well ahead of budget for the year. We discussed some of the class consolidation issues so those of us who were attending the Runoffs would be prepared to chat about it with members.

EVAC (10/9): The committee published Electric Touring spec lines so the TAC would have a place to start when classifying these cars. We focused on various ways to spread the EV word. We will make an appearance at the quarterly RE Zoom calls as well as author updated articles and press releases in SportsCar News (online information available on the SCCA website). We are working on revising some SCCA documents to accommodate EVs.

GLDiv RE meeting (10/14): The REs met with the GLDiv BoD to discuss some topics. One was next spring’s divisional conference. We reviewed the budget and financial status. I also gave an update.

CRB (10/15): This meeting was slid back a week due to the Runoffs being held earlier in the month. The committee worked on adjusting the class consolidations. There were also a few letters that needed attention. The results of all of the CRB rules changes can be seen [here](#).

BoD (10/28): Our monthly meeting was cancelled as we would meet face to face in December.

SCCA Events:

SCCA National Championship Runoffs at Road America (9/28 – 10/6): I did not attend the Runoffs as an official. I was merely there as a spectator and crew. I would gladly speak with anyone about a specific topic. As I wasn’t expensing anything to the club, my week would consist of watching sessions, helping friends where I could and schmoozing.

I arrived on Saturday (9/28) around 5p. My timing was impeccable as I only had to help put up one canopy. I was sharing a house with several friends and we headed over there after we had set up camp for the week’s festivities. As it was less than two miles from the track entrance, it was quite convenient for us.

The week was marred by several serious accidents as we were all reminded that the track is fast, it has very little runoff area and it eats motors. And when it bites, it bites HARD. I just happened to be visiting a friend in the Safety Steward office when the SM incident that involved Danny Steyn and Jim Drago occurred. We all held our collective breath during that one.

I had a very nice time. The weather cooperated (remember the soaked June Sprints a few months earlier?), we ate well and there were some great races. I encourage everyone to check out the results ([link](#)), reads the articles ([link](#)) and watch the broadcasts on YouTube ([link](#)).

Non-SCCA Events:

I attended a go karting race down near Indianapolis on 10/24 – 10/26. The race was held at White-land Raceway Park and was hosted by the folks at [Blue Shock Race](#). They designed and built electric go karts. They are from Latvia but have a US importer. I was invited to the event and was very curious to see how the karts performed. I was also interested in how they handled the safety aspects of this kind of technology. I was heartened to see how well designed the karts were and how well they functioned. They were amazingly quick. With 35 horsepower and weighing just a couple of hundred pounds (with driver), they were extremely quick. They put on quite a show. I fully expect these karts to become very popular and look forward to seeing them at Solos.

#### Nominations

A Neohio member has to make the nomination

The nomination must include a letter including why the nomination is being made, plus the person's bio with their SCCA related accomplishments.
