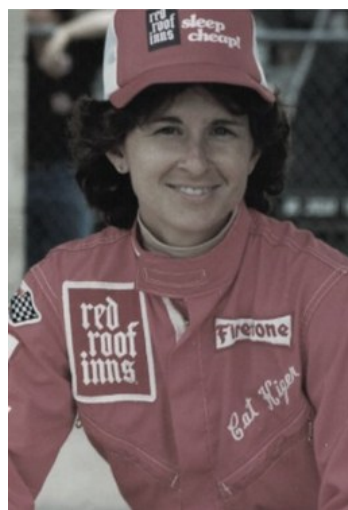

A Neohio member has to make the nomination

The nomination must include a letter including why the nomination is being made, plus the person's bio with their SCCA related accomplishments.
