There were panels on all sorts of topics and each was well attended. Your GLDiv BoD deserves all the credit for organizing such a fantastic meeting. That said, singular praise must go to Val McCammon as, once again, she herded the cats which allowed the gathering to be very informative.

When next year's event rolls around, I hope every member considers attending the convention. Yes, regional leaders and event coordinators learn about strategies and best practices for hosting better events, but a member who isn't on the "inside" can learn so much about how the process works and who the players are at all levels.....national, divisional and regional.

I will let you know that the GLDiv BoD is already working on the event, and its date will be published soon.

Here's what I did since my last report.....

Video Conference Meetings:

Club Racing Board (CRB) (2/4): The group discussed topics for the agenda at our face to face meeting in Kansas City in April. Details about a tire testing program were considered. We also worked on making sure we collected data from the Hoosier Super Tour (HST) events. This will allow for a more effective balance of performance. Electrified Vehicle Advisory Committee (EVAC) (2/12): The committee worked on our outreach for the next quarter. We also discussed the Electric Touring (ET) spec lines that the Touring Advisory Committee (TAC) is working on.

Board of Directors (2/24): The group hear a report from Mike Cobb and Heyward Wagner about the tragic events out in California that resulted in the death of an SCCA member while participating at a Solo event. As for the financial report, the club finished the year very strongly and showed a good profit for the year. Expenses were down while memberships, licenses and sanction fees were up. We have hired a new IT guy to help augment our team. We also hired a new Assistant Road Racing Manager. We are also looking for a replacement for Jeff Dahnert. He will be retiring soon and will be sorely missed.

Tom Wieland suggested that the region open an interest earning savings account to gain from our account balance. Joe Blaha to discuss with our bank (PNC) and report next month.

Joe Blaha requested a budget of \$1,800 for 2024 tax preparation. So moved by John McFarland, seconded by Tom Wieland, and approved without objection.

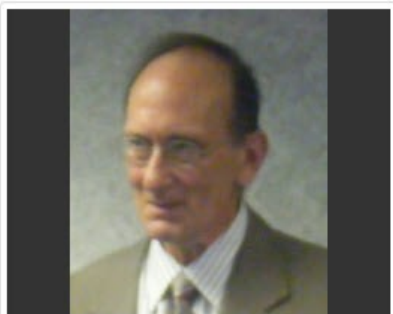
2025 SCCA US Road Rally Challenge (USRRC), October 10-12, 2025

After being asked once again to seriously consider hosting the SCCA US Road Rally Challenge, Neohio Region has agreed to present three rallies over three consecutive days in October. Here are the (very preliminary) concepts for these rallies:

- 1) Friday, October 10 - **Johnny Appleseed**, Canton, Ohio. Absolutely straightforward afternoon/evening TSD rally heading southeast through Ohio's Muskingum Watershed Conservancy District, and on south through the Appalachian foothills to an overnight halt in/near Marietta, Ohio. The Johnny Appleseed name is a legacy from a National Rally first hosted by Neohio Region in the 1950's. The rally has changed form over the decades, but the name endures.
- 2) Saturday, October 11 - **Ohio Milk Run**, Marietta, Ohio. Absolutely straightforward TSD rally running northbound, and parallel to, but slightly west of Friday's route. The Milk Run name is an homage to an old motorcycle enduro that ran in the same area.
- 3) Sunday, October 12 - **Cleveland Alley Rallye**, Cleveland, Ohio. The Alley Rallye will be a resurrection of a once hugely popular annual event organized by the now-defunct Cleveland Sport Car Club, starting in the 1950's. It is a lighthearted tour that will introduce participants to the full spectrum of Cleveland's urban landscape: the post-industrial "Flats", distinct ethnic neighborhoods, grids of narrow brick streets separating century-old warehouses, mazes of alleys and loading docks beneath theaters and office towers, and breathtaking views of the mighty Cuyahoga River (yes, THAT Cuyahoga - the one that burned!).
