New Business:

Brandon Anderson requested a budget of \$10,000 for the June TT in addition to the monies already approved for the track rental. Bill Crowe moved to approve a budget of \$10,000 for the June TT, seconded by Ashley Medwig, and approved without objection.

Brenda Nick reported she has made copies of the key(s) for the locked Timing & Scoring cabinets in the Nelson Timing tower and distributed them to the following: Bob MacDonald, Ashley Medwig, Marie Bohusch, and herself. Brenda will keep the original at home.

Marie Bohusch suggested at Road Race events drivers should bring their video with them when they file a dispute with the race stewards. This could save time in getting the dispute resolved. Race Chairs should consider adding this to the event supps.

Adjournment: A motion to adjourn was made by Bill Crowe, seconded by Ray Glover, meeting adjourned at 8:38pm.

Next trustee's meeting will be June 3, 2025 via Zoom at 7:30 pm.

Notes from the Director's Chair Area 4 Director Update June 2025

June has me visiting Road America for the June Sprints (6/5-6/9) and volunteering as Pace Car pilot at a WMR Regional at Grattan Raceway (6/14, 6/15). Meanwhile, the CRB and BoD are getting ready for a face to face meeting in Kansas City in July and the CRB is working hard to prepare for the Runoffs at Road America.

Here's what I did since my last report.....

Video Conference Meetings:

Club Racing Board (CRB) (5/6): I reported on my conversation with Sean Hedrick (Spec Miata Advisory Committee Chair). He had some useful ideas about reaching out to the drivers corps to get them more engaged. There was a conversation about entry numbers for the program so far this season. It appears we are down a bit from last year. This is probably dues to a variety of economic conditions which have created uncertainty in budgeting. We discussed the agenda for our upcoming face to face meeting in Kansas City. We also chatted about the preparation for the Runoffs. The results of all of the CRB rules changes can be seen here.

Electrified Vehicle Advisory Committee (EVAC) (5/14): The committee hosted a couple of guests (Jim Garry-NEDiv Solo Safety Steward and Chris Robbins-SCCA Regional Development Director). The EVAC offered guidance to Jim on how his division could implement some basic awareness and safety protocols for EV participation at Solo events. Chris shared how we could use previously created content to generate modules on EV safety for the online Solo Safety Steward refresher course as well as other online safety courses. We also discussed how to integrate the Prototype Electric (PE) and Electric Touring (ET) into the GCR.

Board of Directors (5/19): Due to the Memorial Day holiday, this meeting was held a week earlier than normal. Our financial posture is fine. We are still a bit behind budget but have plenty of time to adjust. We discussed a format change for our F2F meeting in Kansas City in July (7/25, 7/26). The new BoD Chair (Bob Crawford) wants to be able to spend more time on pertinent topics and less on staff updates. This would allow for deeper dives into salient discussions. We also wrapped up the topic of the gender pronouns in our documents. A plan is now in place to revise all SCCA documents (rules packages, by laws, training manuals, etc.) over the next few months. Please be patient as this will take some time to achieve.

SCCA Events:

OVR @ MidOhio (5/16-5/18): I travelled to this event as both Area 4 Director and CRB Chair. I wanted to see how the event was run by the region and national staff. I also used the trip to schedule conversations with several people while I was at the track. The weather was chaotic.

The weather was chaotic. 90⁺F on Thursday for load in, almost as warm on Friday and then cold and windy with on and off showers for Saturday and Sunday. Very nasty storms Friday night/Saturday morning left some canopies in disarray. Ugh! By and large the races went off smoothly. The Production cars had a lap one incident that caused a full course yellow for the rest of the session on Saturday. The remaining groups all went fairly well. I'd count the event as a qualified success. While the entry count was down from 2024, the region put on a pretty good event.

2025 SCCA US Road Rally Challenge (USRRC), October 10-12, 2025

After being asked once again to seriously consider hosting the SCCA US Road Rally Challenge, Neohio Region has agreed to present three rallies over three consecutive days in October. Here are the (preliminary) concepts for these rallies:

- 1) Friday, October 10 **Johnny Appleseed Rally** (JAR), Canton, Ohio. Absolutely straightforward afternoon/ evening TSD rally winding southeast through Ohio's Muskingum Watershed Conservancy District (MWCD), then south through the Appalachian foothills, to an overnight halt in Marietta, Ohio. "Tulip" style route instructions will be used. To help those with limited previous timekeeping experience stay on schedule, parenthetical perfect cumulative times will be provided for nearly all instructions. The Johnny Appleseed name is a legacy from a National Rally first hosted by Neohio Region in the 1950's. The rally has changed form over the decades, but the name endures. Rallymaster: Greg Lester.
- 2) Saturday, October 11 **Ohio Milk Run** (OMR), Marietta, Ohio. Another absolutely straightforward TSD rally running northbound, and parallel to, but slightly west of Friday's route. The Milk Run name is an homage to an old motorcycle enduro that ran in the same area. Rallymaster: Ron Johnstonbaugh
- 3) Sunday, October 12 **Cleveland Alley Rallye**, Cleveland, Ohio. The Alley Rallye will be a resurrection of a once hugely popular annual event organized by the now-defunct Cleveland Sport Car Club, starting in the 1950's. It is a lighthearted (and lightly trapped...) jaunt that will introduce participants to the full spectrum of Cleveland's urban landscape: the post-industrial "Flats", distinct ethnic neighborhoods, grids of narrow brick streets separating century-old warehouses, mazes of alleys and loading docks beneath theaters and office towers, and numerous breathtaking views of the mighty Cuyahoga River (yes, THAT Cuyahoga the one that burned!). Timekeeping equipment will be restricted to stock odometer and a basic four function non-programmable calculator (i.e. all teams will run at equal disadvantage). Rallymaster: Jeff Arendas. The Richta automated timing system will be used for all 3 rallies.

Competitors of all experience levels are encouraged to enter these rallies.
