Area 4 Director Update July 2025

July has the CRB and BoD face to face meetings in Kansas City and the CRB is working hard to prepare for the Runoffs at Road America.

I've been asked by Frank Schwartz (divisional Club Racing points keeper) to alert the membership about a couple of things. One, the GLDiv points are now stashed in the cloud. Go to the [GLDiv site](#), choose Programs and then Road Racing. When the page loads, choose "Click here for current points standings". You'll find the spreadsheet there. Two, decals are required to participate in the Regional Championship Series (RCS). These decals should be available at the track. Check with the folks in Tech. If you have any questions, please drop an email to [Frank](#) and he'll help you out.

Here's what I did since my last report.....

Video Conference Meetings:

Club Racing Board (CRB) (6/3): The group discussed SMX at length. The sealed engine idea has been turned into a "What do you think" (WDYT) and will be sent to the populous in the next Fastrack. SMX data reports were reviewed. The FSRAC will be conducting a survey of FV drivers about a tire rule. Once again, we continued the discussion on the agenda for our upcoming face to face meeting in Kansas City. We also chatted about the preparation for the Runoffs. Electrified Vehicle Advisory Committee (EVAC) (6/11): This meeting was cancelled due to family being in town.

Board of Directors (6/23): We reviewed the report on the 2024 audit. It showed some very good numbers for the year. As for 2025, our financial posture is fine. We are still a bit behind budget and corrections are being made to accommodate the minor shortfall. We discussed a 'member behaving badly' with Chris Robbins. We reviewed the SCCA Foundation grant process and will work to streamline it for future recipients. We also discussed the logistics of our F2F meeting in July.

SCCA Events:

CHI @ Road America (6/6 - 6/8): For this event I had my CRB Chair hat on. Like the MidOhio trip, I also used the visit to schedule conversations with several people while I was at the track. I had a broad agenda and would need all three days to accomplish it.

Fortunately, the weather cooperated this year. I had my e bike and I rode 23 miles inside the track during the weekend as meetings and conversations were held at a wide variety of locations. In the end, I am glad I went. I was able to split time between “business” and watching sessions. What a great facility.....I can’t wait for the Runoffs so I can go back.

WMR @ Grattan Raceway (6/14, 6/15): Once again, I was asked to drive the pace car and I happily accepted. The event had five race groups, and each group had five sessions over the course of the weekend (practice, qualifying, a qualifying race and two points races). I am glad to say that each session went green to checker. No full course yellows, no black flag alls.....the drivers did a great job of minimizing contact and breakdowns. The volunteers were able to clean up incidents under local yellows. That left me with only pacing responsibilities and no safety car duties. The weather cooperated with sunny skies and mild temperatures. What else could one ask for?

I gave rides to a couple of friends while on duty. I look forward to pacing again at the Major in August. I was also able to talk shop with several members who had questions for me. It does me good to have conversations with members about topics in which they are interested. If you see me at an event, please do not hesitate to ask me something.

2025 SCCA US Road Rally Challenge (USRRC), October 10-12, 2025

After being asked once again to seriously consider hosting the SCCA US Road Rally Challenge, Neohio Region has agreed to present three rallies over three consecutive days in October. Here are the (preliminary) concepts for these rallies:

1) Friday, October 10 - **Johnny Appleseed Rally** (JAR), Canton, Ohio. Absolutely straightforward afternoon/evening TSD rally winding southeast through Ohio's Muskingum Watershed Conservancy District (MWCD), then south through the Appalachian foothills, to an overnight halt in Marietta, Ohio. "Tulip" style route instructions will be used. To help those with limited previous timekeeping experience stay on schedule, parenthetical perfect cumulative times will be provided for nearly all instructions. The Johnny Appleseed name is a legacy from a National Rally first hosted by Neohio Region in the 1950's. The rally has changed form over the decades, but the name endures. Rallymaster: Greg Lester.

2) Saturday, October 11 - **Ohio Milk Run** (OMR), Marietta, Ohio. Another absolutely straightforward TSD rally running northbound, and parallel to, but slightly west of Friday's route. The Milk Run name is an homage to an old motorcycle enduro that ran in the same area. Rallymaster: Ron Johnstonbaugh

3) Sunday, October 12 - **Cleveland Alley Rallye**, Cleveland, Ohio. The Alley Rallye will be a resurrection of a once hugely popular annual event organized by the now-defunct Cleveland Sport Car Club, starting in the 1950's. It is a lighthearted (and lightly trapped...) jaunt that will introduce participants to the full spectrum of Cleveland's urban landscape: the post-industrial "Flats", distinct ethnic neighborhoods, grids of narrow brick streets separating century-old warehouses, mazes of alleys and loading docks beneath theaters and office towers, and numerous breathtaking views of the mighty Cuyahoga River (yes, THAT Cuyahoga - the one that burned!). Timekeeping equipment will be restricted to stock odometer and a basic four function non-programmable calculator (i.e. - all teams will run at equal disadvantage). Rallymaster: Jeff Arendas.

The Richta automated timing system will be used for all 3 rallies.

Competitors of all experience levels are encouraged to enter these rallies.

Friday, October 10th will feature the **Johnny Appleseed Rally** from Canton down to Marietta, Ohio. Saturday, October 11th will be the **Ohio Milk Run**, using a different route to return to Canton. These will both be straightforward TSD style rallies. On Sunday, for a fun twist on the sport, the **Cleveland Alley Rally** is being resurrected. For this day, equipment is restricted to a stock odometer and a basic four function calculator. Richta automated timing will be used for all three rallies. Competitors of all experience levels are encouraged to enter any or all of these rallies.
