### Trustee Meeting Minutes, November 4 2025

**Call to Order:** The Zoom meeting was called to order by R.E. Bob MacDonald at 7:32pm.

**Review of Prior Minutes:** Minutes from the October 7, 2025 Zoom meeting were emailed to the Board by Ray Glover for review prior to the meeting. A motion to accept the minutes as corrected was made by Kurt Stevens, seconded by John McFarland, and approved without objection.

**Treasurer's Report:** Joe Blaha emailed his November treasurer's report to the board prior the meeting and reported the following. The cash balance is down from last month and up from last year. A motion to approve the November treasurer's report was made by Brenda Nick, seconded by Tom Wieland, and approved without objection. The order of business was temporarily suspended so Joe could complete his business with the board and be excused early:

Per previous discussions and research into earning interest on the money in the region's checking account – Joe requested that he be approved to deposit money from the region's checking account into a four-month certificate of deposit to earn 3.9% interest. After discussion, Bill Crowe moved to allow Joe to deposit cash into the four-month CD and a lesser amount into a money market account (exact amounts to be at Joe's discretion). Motion seconded by John McFarland and approved without objection.

Joe also requested a budget of \$125 for new checks. A motion to approve a budget of \$125 for checks was made by Kurt Stevens, seconded by Tom Wieland, and approved without objection.

Joe noted that he will need a new version of QuickBooks and will bring it up at next month's meeting.

Brandon Anderson brought up for discussion the possibility of the region providing \$250 per person (board members and/or program chairs only) to attend the Great Lake Division meeting in February 2026. After discussion the topic was tabled until next month's meeting.

Regarding the 2026 "A Day of Motorsports," Bob MacDonald noted that SCCA Foundation has discontinued the grant program that we used to partially fund the event. We do have some sponsors. Do we want to do the program on our own? To be discussed next month.

Dave Lancaster noted that Pitt Race will be auctioning some items we might be interested in – flags, radios, transponders, etc. It should be online in early December.

**Adjournment:** A motion to adjourn was made by Bill Crowe, seconded by Ray Glover, meeting adjourned at 9:10pm.

Next trustee's meeting will be December 2, 2025 via Zoom at 7:30 pm.
