Carl Goodwin is an accomplished writer of motorsports stories. He has just been inducted into the Neohio Hall of Fame. Here is a note he sent to the editor some time ago. I think you will enjoy this.

It's still 1957

In 1957, sports car racing was just getting started. Due to the kind of people it attracted, there was a high level of sportsmanship. At one of the early Watkins Glen races, Porsche Spyder driver Bob Holbert blew out a clutch plate. Seeing competitor Don Sessler pull into the track, he went over and asked if he had a spare. Sessler said ""Let me pull over to the side here and I'll take a look for it." Don rummaged through his spares and looked. Moments later he said "Here it is!" and handed it over.

At the Put-in-Bay race in 1958, former NEOhio Regional Executive Reed Andrews burned a couple of valves during practice with his Triumph TR-3. He was packing up his things in the car when his friends the Holder Brothers came by. They had a machine shop in Cleveland and had completely re-done the gears in their Porsche Spyder. "What's the matter?," Lorrain asked. Reed only knew his car was running on three cylinders. "Let's take a look," Manny said. In no time at all the head was off, confirming the burnt valves. They called a dealer on the mainland and located the parts, then flew over to get them. By late afternoon the car was back together and ready to race the next day. "I took a third place in E-Production," Reed recalled, "thanks to Manny and Lorrain."

Much more recently, at Nelson Ledges and the Pat Prill Memorial Race, one of my wheels loosened up and I pulled off the course with broken axle bolts. After the tow into the paddock, I got out my supply of replacement bolts and put them on the ground next to the left rear wheel. I stepped away for a few moments and when I came back, there was Eric Fiest of Kryderacing finishing the replacement of the bolts in my axle. He wouldn't take any payment but he did say "You're welcome. I'm glad I could help."

The years have passed but in many ways it's still 1957. And we're still the sport we used to be.

2026 Neohio Hall of Fame Induction

To honor those who contributed to the region through their volunteer work or who brought honor to the region for their accomplishments

Our 2026 inductees are:

Carl Goodwin

The Gift of Storytelling: Preserving Bygone Lore and Tales of Our beloved Sport

Carl Goodwin's love of racing lead him to write about history that would otherwise be lost, thus preserving it for future generations to enjoy. His books and articles were extensively researched including: letters, personal interviews, telephone interviews, and e-mails. He has gone to great lengths to get accurate information. Example: he drove to Ashtabula to get a picture of Mitzi, the Sowbelly Rally traveling trophy.

Carl was first introduced to sports car racing when he was 15 years old. He started racing in 1960, including a Fiat Abarth, Formula Ford, a Karmann Ghia, and a Sprite. Prior to his retirement from racing, Carl drove a familiar bright blue #94, a 1962 Austin Healey Sprite. Now Carl has a Regional Sound Control license. He has been an SCCA member since 1987 and a NEOHIO member since 2004.

In 1978, he returned to the corners. In 1980 he saw the need for a Starter and pursued that.


