For those who enjoy stage rallying (flat-out racing against the clock over closed forest roads), an annual pilgrimage to the Southern Ohio Forest Rally (SOFR) is a must. SOFR typically kicks off with a short stage through Yoctangee Park in downtown Chillicothe, Ohio on Thursday evening. Friday and Saturday forest stages are then run in Shawnee State Forest near Portsmouth, Ohio, and in Zaleski State Forest near McArthur, Ohio.

Here's a partial list of positions that need to be filled in order for the rally to operate: Amateur Radio communications. Emergency Medical coverage. Pre/post event stage setup and teardown. Stage Start/Finish check-in and timing. Stage access point marshalling. Spectator area marshalling. Service area setup/operation. Etc.
