**Call to Order:** The Zoom meeting was called to order by R.E. Bob MacDonald at 7:32pm.

**Review of Prior Minutes:** Minutes from the March, 2026 Zoom meeting were emailed to the Board by Ray Glover for review prior to the meeting. A motion to accept the minutes as corrected was made by Kurt Stevens, seconded by Brandon Anderson, and approved without objection.

**Treasurer's Report:** Joe Blaha emailed his April treasurer's report to the board prior the meeting and reported the following. The cash balance is up from last month and also from last year. Joe to look for the receipt from Boss Pro regarding the Intro to Motorsports deposit and follow up with Brandon. Bob MacDonald noted a discrepancy in the award celebration loss calculation and requested a separate discussion with Joe to review the numbers. Joe confirmed the Hall of Fame fund paid for the comped dinners for the inductees. Ann was instrumental in creating the Longest Day of Nelson 24-hour races. Our thoughts are with her husband Ed Mallinak.

The **Longest Day of Nelson** was conceived in 1980, when a group of racing enthusiasts, led by John McGill, Grover Griggs and Ann McHugh, came up with the idea to hold an amateur 24-hour [endurance race](#) for purely showroom stock vehicles<sup>[1]</sup> at the [Nelson Ledges Road Course](#) in Ohio, which would take place on or near the summer solstice each year. Sanctioned by the [Sports Car Club of America](#) (SCCA), the host of the event was the Northeast Ohio Region of the SCCA (credit Wikipedia).

#### **2026 Southern Ohio Forest Rally (SOFR), June 11-13, 2026:**

For those who enjoy stage rallying (flat-out racing against the clock over closed forest roads), an annual pilgrimage to the Southern Ohio Forest Rally (SOFR) is a must. SOFR typically kicks off with a short stage through Yoctangee Park in downtown Chillicothe, Ohio on Thursday evening. Friday and Saturday forest stages are then run in Shawnee State Forest near Portsmouth, Ohio, and in Zaleski State Forest near McArthur, Ohio.

A "cast of thousands" of volunteers is needed to staff the stages and rally service area. Here's a partial list of positions that need to be filled in order for the rally to operate: Amateur Radio communications. Emergency Medical coverage. Pre/post event stage setup and teardown. Stage Start/Finish check-in and timing. Stage access point marshalling. Spectator area marshalling. Service area setup/operation. Etc.
