Call to Order: The Zoom meeting was called to order by R.E. Bob MacDonald at 7:34pm.

Review of Prior Minutes: Minutes from the June 2, 2026 Zoom meeting were emailed to the Board by Ray Glover for review prior to the meeting. A motion to accept the minutes as corrected was made by Taylor Allen, seconded by Brenda Nick, and approved without objection.

Treasurer's Report: Joe Blaha emailed his June treasurer's report to the board prior to the meeting and reported the following. The cash balance is up from last month and last year. A motion to approve the June treasurer's report as presented was made by Kurt Stevens, seconded by John McFarland, and approved without objection.

Trustee – Carry out the purpose of the Region, manage affairs, property and assets of the region. On behalf of the general membership, vote on policies and activities of the region, approving suitable budgets and other decisions. 3 year term with 3 terms expiring each year for a total of nine Trustees.

Bob Roberts has been in contact with the Winking Lizard Party Center for February 26, 2027 for our annual Awards Celebration. Bob MacDonald is requesting a budget of up to \$1,200 for a deposit.
