Recording Secretary – Keep the minutes of all meetings of the members and Board and serve as custodian for all documents and records of the region. 1 year term.

Treasurer – Receive, manage, record and disburse funds belonging to the Region, submit statements of accounts at Board Meetings and oversee the Audit process. 1 year term.

Membership Secretary – Keep record of Region members, report current membership information, manage communications and take a leadership role in recruiting new members. 1 year term.

Trustee – Carry out the purpose of the Region, manage affairs, property and assets of the region. On behalf of the general membership, vote on policies and activities of the region, approving suitable budgets and other decisions. 3 year term with 3 terms expiring each year for a total of nine Trustees.
